

Social advice

Information for patients and their relatives



Rehabilitation means that people are confronted with a new situation in life after an illness or an accident and have to return to their everyday life under different conditions.

Social and occupational integration is an important objective of rehabilitation. Social advice supports you during this process.

Personal and family advice

Support with adjusting to the new everyday and transitional situations, adapted to the individual needs.

Insurance cover

Help with settling claims from various forms of insurance and support during discussions with insurance company representatives.

Financing

Clarifying financial contributions for aids, home adaptations and emergency situations related to the disability. Compensation of benefactors and other necessary expenses.

Legal matters

Support in legal matters such as family law, employment law, tenancy law, and child and adult protection law. If necessary, we bring in legal experts, particularly with regard to matters of liability.

Housing

Support with looking for suitable private and/or assisted housing.

Post-inpatient care and nursing

Initial contact and support with coordinating care organisations and advice services.



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
